marine scientific institutions, is broadcasting information about the Cape and Islands for your enjoyment.

THE BROADCASTS are part of a demonstration project on the use of low power AM radio technology. The entire broadcast lasts less than 15 minutes. In between broadcasts, you'll be able to hear a few minutes of local weather from NOAA's Weather Radio.
