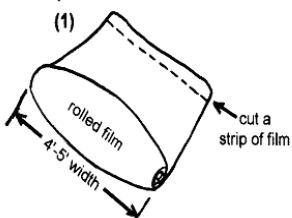
How to Remove Boat Shrink Wrap and Prevent Contamination

Remove all vents, zippers and any other non-shrink wrap material. **This includes removing the plastic straps that cinch the wrap to the belly of the boat.**

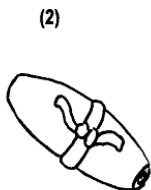


Cut the wrap above the strap at the belly of the boat, so the strap falls away, leaving only shrink wrap.

Once all non-shrink wrap has been removed, the wrap should be bundled and tied with a strip of shrink wrap.



1) Fold the film into a width of 4-5 feet, roll the film up and then cut off a strip of film from the end of the roll...



(2) and use the strip of film to tie the bundle.
