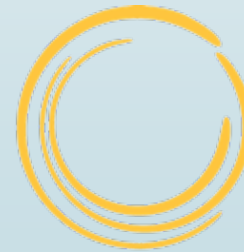
HELP PUT BENTHIC MAPPING TO WORK IN WAQUOIT BAY
